

This building was originally designed as a residence in 1898. Earthquakes led to extensive interior damage, nevertheless the facade and some interior walls were preserved; these can be seen throughout the museum. The building was designated a historic site in the early 1980's and was subsequently fully renovated in compliance with stringent anti-seismic building codes.

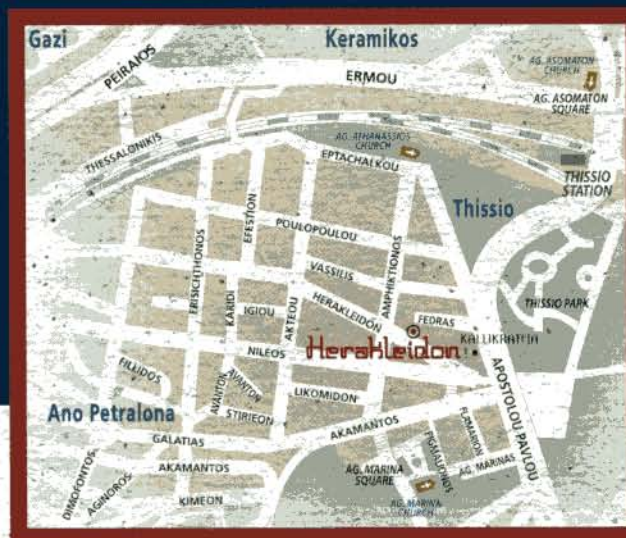

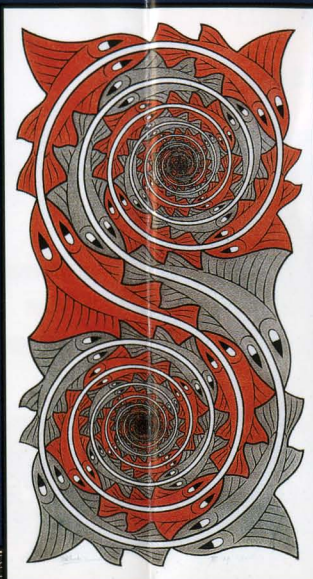

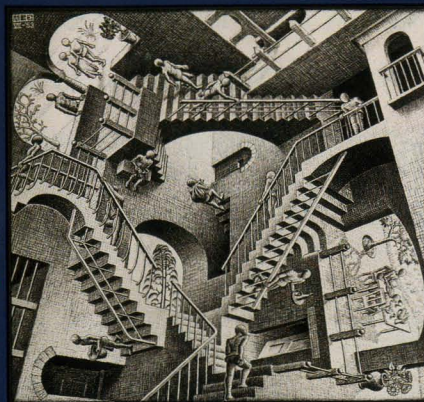

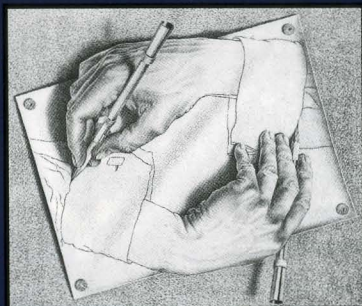

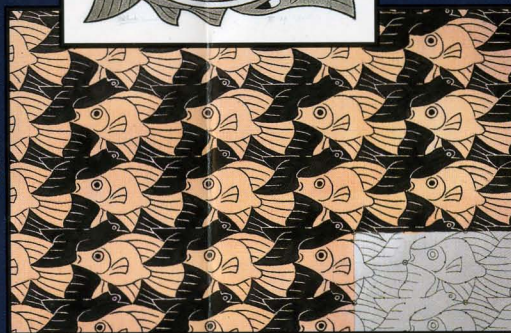
Sphere Spirals, woodcut, 1958



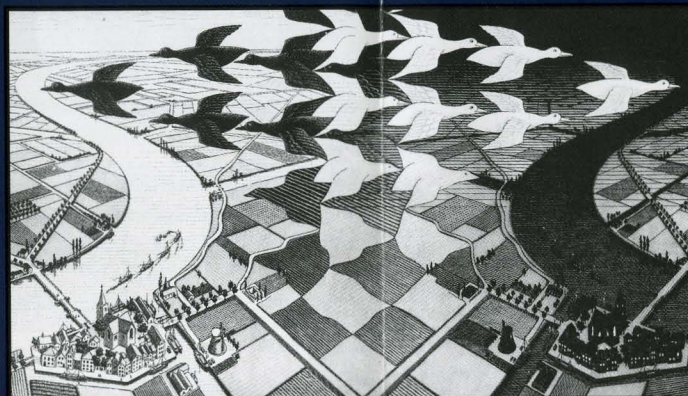

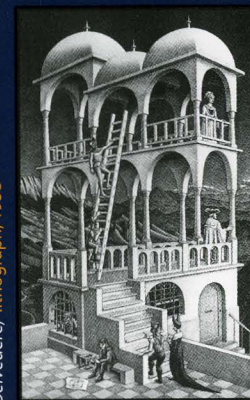
