## **Introduction to urban development planning**

Student assessment in the **Introduction to urban development planning** course will result from the project and the 3 papers analysis.

### **Paper Analysis Instructions**

Each paper analysis should address the following questions:

- What is the principal research question of the paper?
- Are the geospatial dataset, working scale, and chosen methodology appropriate for addressing the paper's main question?
- Do the results effectively answer the paper's principal question?
- Are the conclusions clear and consistent with the paper's main objectives?

Each paper analysis should be between **500 - 1,000** words.

The analyses of the three papers must be submitted by **14.01.2026**, via email to the professors.

### **Group Project Assignment**

The project will have an empirical focus.

The project title must be finalized by **05.11.2025**.

Each project will include both an oral presentation and a written Student Paper.

The presentation should not exceed **20 minutes** in duration.

The final Student Paper must be submitted by **14.01.2026**, via email to the professors.

The paper should be between **4,000** and **6,000** words, supplemented with appropriate documentation (e.g., maps, tables, diagrams, and other visual materials).

The topic should address issues that: (a) were discussed within the lectures, (b) were developed in the proposed papers available in the course repository, or (c) are selected by the student in consultation with the professors.

Each submission must be accompanied by an **Turnitin** self-report statement.
